UPDATE: LEAD PROVIDER INSPECTION PROCESS

Ofsted is in the process of inspecting ECF lead providers. Our lead provider, Ambition Institute is yet to be inspected. When it does happen, and if we are one of the delivery partners selected to be part of the process, inspectors will speak to early ECTs, mentors, induction tutors and school leaders. UPDATE: REGISTERING ECTs STARTING IN 23/24

The DfE anticipates that registration for ECTs and mentors on the DfE Portal will open at the start of July. We will keep you updated and do all we can in our control to make the process a smooth one!



UPDATE: NPQs



This term our first groups completed their programmes and associated assessments. The commitment, dedication and insights shown throughout the programmes, but especially in this final phase has been inspiring. Well done all involved.

At the time of writing, assessments have been completed for specialist programmes (NPQLT, NPQLTD, NPQLBC) and our NPQSL and NPQH participants complete their case study assessment early next term.

After Easter we share registration details for the full funded Autumn '23 starting NPQ programmes. Additional payments are also available for schools with less than 600 pupils to help support their teachers and leaders to undertake NPQs – a grant payment of £200/participant enrolling on an NPQ.




